

What to expect during your visit



The safety and wellbeing of staff and visitors to the Rampion Visitor Centre is our utmost priority. With this in mind, we have put the following safety measures in place, in line with Government guidelines.

Booking your visit:

Pre-book your time slot. All sessions at the visitor centre are pre-book only, to help maintain social distance.

Sessions are 30 minutes each, but you are welcome to come back another time if you want to see more.

Please ensure that all members of your group are part of a single household.

You and your group will have exclusive use of the Visitor Centre, with just our staff team present.

On the day of your visit:

We ask that if you or anyone within your group is showing any symptoms of Covid-19 on the day, that you **do not visit**.

To minimise queueing, please do not arrive any earlier than 5 minutes before your booking time.

There is a designated outdoor space where you can wait and will be greeted by a member of staff.

All visitors will be asked to undergo a non-invasive temperature check on arrival. If anyone has a high temperature, your group will not be able to visit on that day.

Please remember to follow social distancing guidelines whilst inside the Visitor Centre.

Visitors will be required to wear a face mask whilst inside the visitor centre, unless they are exempt.

Additional Health and Safety measures:

Time is allocated between each booking to allow staff to sanitise all of the touch surfaces and displays within the Visitor Centre.

Staff will wear personal protective equipment (PPE) where required to keep both themselves and our visitors safe.

There will be hand sanitising stations at the entrance and exit. All visitors will be asked to use these prior to entry.

Our Visitor Centre staff will also undergo daily temperature checks.



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
