

# How to make a windmill



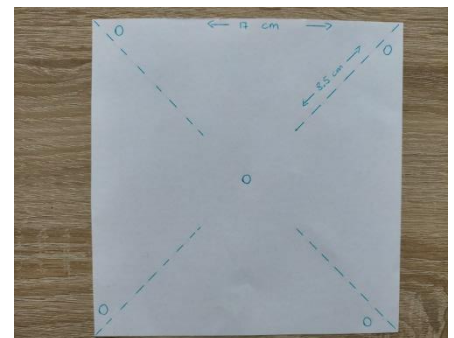
## What you'll need:

A4 sheet of paper, pushpin, paper straw, scissors, colouring pens, ruler, and glue.



## Method:

First make the template by drawing a square on your A4 sheet of paper using a ruler, the sides need to be 17cm long, and then draw 4 dotted lines from the corners of the square towards the centre, roughly 8.5cm long, draw tiny circles in each corner as per this picture:



Cut out the square and colour the front and back, you can use whatever patterns or pictures you like drawing most and make it as colourful as you like!



Cut along the dotted lines (be careful not to cut right to the centre, you will need the centre for gluing and attaching the pin).

One by one, fold the corners with circles on them into the centre part of the windmill gluing them down as you go; make sure all the little circles go right on top of the one in the middle of the windmill.

Allow the glue to dry.



Secure on top of the paper straw with the pushpin:



Your windmill is now ready to be tested in the wind!
