

MARINE AND COASTAL ACCESS ACT 2009

APPLICATION FOR REMOVAL OF SOUTHERN WATER OUTFALL PIPE

Notice is hereby given that Rampion Offshore Wind Limited has applied to the Marine Management Organisation under the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, Part 4, for a marine licence to undertake removal of a disused outfall pipe. Plans showing the position of the works may be inspected at Worthing Library, Richmond Road, Worthing, BN11 1HD during opening hours.
