Rampion Offshore Wind Limited Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement 2025

Rampion Offshore Wind Limited ("the Company") owns Rampion Offshore Wind Farm, a 400.2 MW offshore wind farm located 13km to 23km off the Sussex coast.

The Company has appointed RWE Renewables UK Wind Services Limited to provide construction services to it under a Construction Management Agreement, operational services under a Management Operation and Maintenance Agreement, energy management services under an Energy Management Services Agreement and management services under a Joint Venture Management Services Agreement.

The Company is committed to both the statutory requirements under the Modern Slavery Act 2015, and to acting with integrity in all its business dealings and relationships to have a zero tolerance approach to Modern Slavery. This is a position which the Company expects all its suppliers to respect and adopt.

The Company has instructed RWE Renewables UK Wind Services Limited to:

- (i) implement and enforce effective systems of controls to ensure that Modern Slavery is not taking place anywhere within either its or the Company's business or in any of its or the Company's supply chains; and
- (ii) ensure that where it contracts are negotiated with third parties in the Company's name and on the Company's behalf that such contracts provide suitable provisions relating to the systems of control that such third parties are taking to ensure that Modern Slavery is not taking place within their business and supply chains.
